Catholic Charities of Northwest California to Launch ‘Charities on Tap’ in Napa County

Community gathering at Napa Yard to spotlight local needs and inspire action

NAPA, CA (May 5, 2026) -- Catholic Charities of Northwest California (CCNWC) will bring its popular Charities on Tap series to Napa County for the first time on Wednesday, May 13, 2026, from 5:30PM – 7:30PM at Napa Yard Beer Garden, located at 585 1st Street, Napa. This free, community-centered gathering invites local residents, partners, and supporters to connect over a relaxed evening of meaningful conversation, shared stories, and a commitment to caring for neighbors in need.

Demand for social services continues to climb across Napa and the North Bay. Individuals and families throughout our region are increasingly forced to choose between basic essentials—food, housing, healthcare, and transportation. This event will highlight that growing need and then discuss several critical CCNWC programs:

- Rainbow House – Napa County’s only family shelter
- Napa Nightingale – A medical respite and support program serving unhoused neighbors
- Permanent Support Housing – Pathways to long-term housing stability for vulnerable individuals

“We’ve seen what happens when people show up for each other; it creates real, tangible change. That’s why we’re so excited to bring this series to Napa, especially after seeing how people in other communities have responded. There’s something powerful when neighbors come together to support each other and uplift one another. We are grateful to play a role in that and create a space for it.”

What To Expect

The community is invited to come as they are, enjoy food and beverages, and take part in meaningful conversations about how the community can better support our neighbors and strengthen our community. The evening will include:

- A closer look at Rainbow House and the county's only family shelter program
- An overview of Napa Nightingale and Permanent Supportive Housing programs
- Stories from staff working directly with families
- A conversation about support and stability in Napa County

While attendance is free, registration is encouraged, and donations are appreciated to support CCNWC's programs throughout Napa County.

Charities on Tap is an ongoing CCNWC event series designed to bring people together in welcoming, community-center spaces to learn, connect, and take part in local impact.
